



What's "SuperCon" ?

The Global Scientific Information and Computing Center (GSIC) at the Tokyo Institute of Technology was established on April 1, 2001 as a 21st century information center. GSIC was formed through the amalgamation of the Computer Center and the International Cooperation Center for Science and Technology of the university. Its objectives will be to support research and education by harnessing the strengths of leading-edge information technologies. It will also promote an active and cooperative exchange of research and education programs among various organizations such as universities, research laboratories, and other institutes, both inside and outside of Japan in order to contribute to the development of international collaboration.

Some participants won a medal in International Mathematical Olympiad and International Olympiad in Informatics. After the Contest, some students are also active in programming contests for university students like ACM International Collegiate Programming Contest.

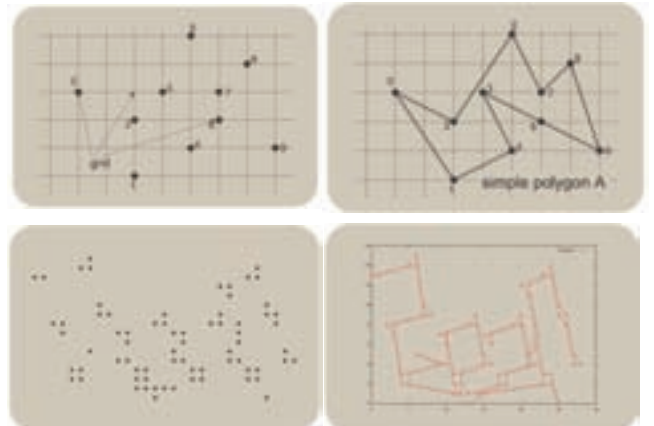


2008 Finals Problem: Area Minimize Problem
